Dear Beryl Ford Public School Families,

To help balance enrolment between schools in our neighbourhood, the Board of Trustees approved a grade re-organization for Thorndale Public School from a kindergarten to grade 6 school to a kindergarten to grade 8 school, beginning September 2019. At the same meeting, the Board also approved a boundary change to Beryl Ford Public School's grade 7 and 8 boundary.

The re-organization and boundary change will be phased in with grade 7, beginning September 2019, followed by grade 8 in September 2020. Students will no longer be directed to Beryl Ford Public School for grades 7 and 8 from Thorndale Public School. **Students currently in grade 7 residing in the Thorndale boundary area will remain at Beryl Ford Public School for grade 8.**

The map on the reverse side of this letter shows the boundary change approved by the Board of Trustees at the Regular Meeting of the Board on November 13, 2018

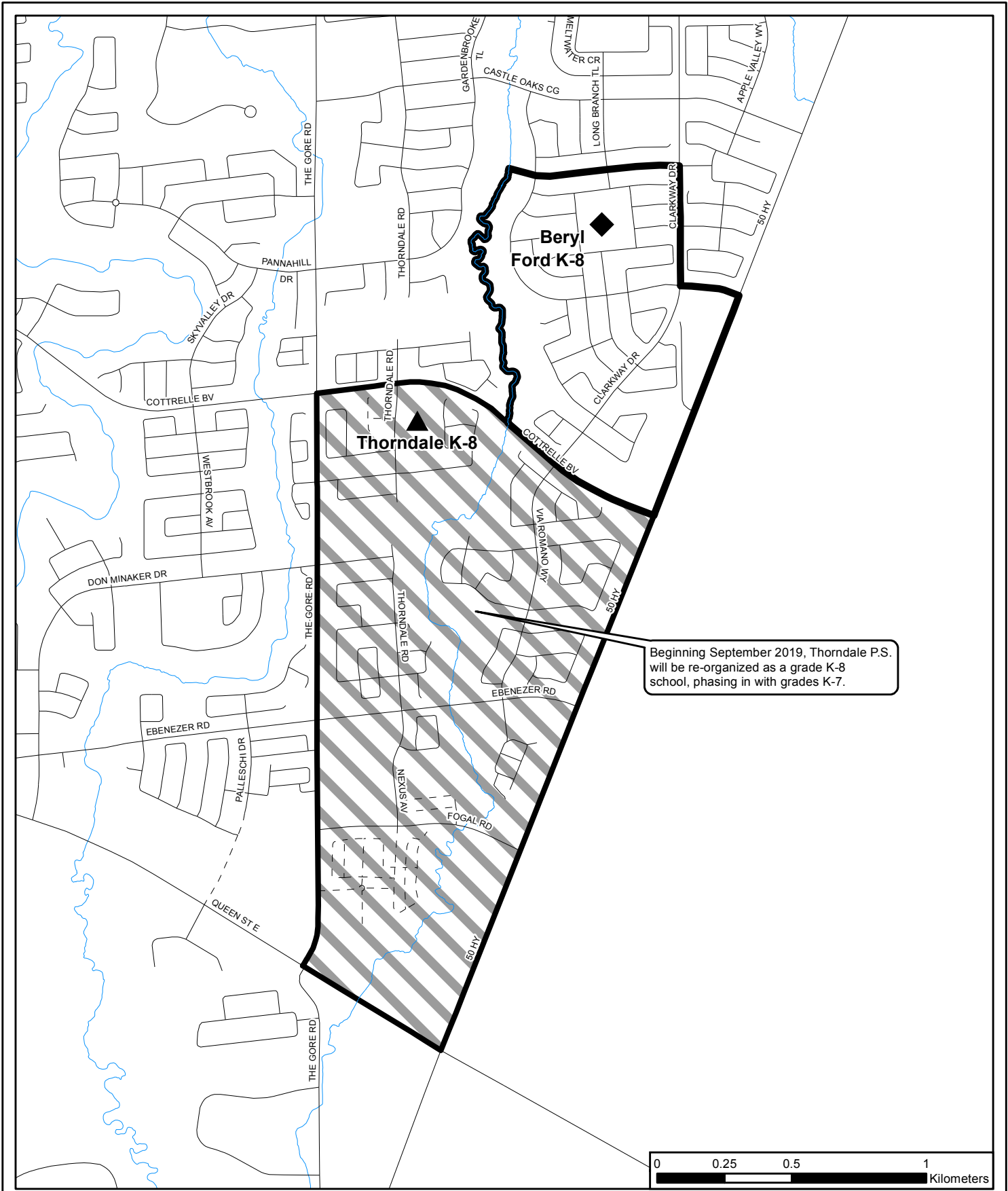
