This event will feature a 60 minute keynote address by John Linney followed by a 15 minute question and answer period for audience members.

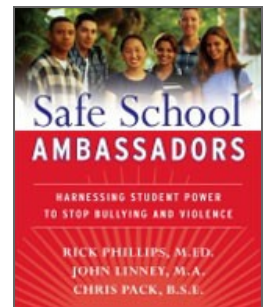
