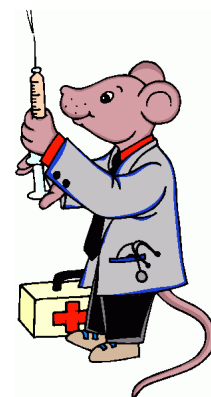


GRADE 1 IMMUNIZATIONS



Dear Grade 1 Families:

When you registered your child for kindergarten, you provided a record of your child's immunizations. In order to attend school in Ontario, your child must have a complete immunization record. It is your responsibility to make sure your child's record is complete.

By now, in addition to all the infant vaccines, your child should have received the final booster dose for diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus and polio (DTap-IPV), which is due between four and six years. Your doctor does not send a record of this immunization to Peel Public Health—you must report this information directly. If you haven't already done so, you can update your child's record in one of four ways:

- Go online to www.immunizepeel.ca and click on '*report your child's immunization*'

If your child's record is not complete and you do not have a valid exemption, your child may not be allowed to attend school.
