MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 100 total points must be earned
- Participation in at least 3 different clubs/organizations
- No more than 50 points may be earned per club/organization



STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Ensure the teacher-sponsor for each club/organization that you participate in completes your tracking form at the end of each activity (each semester or year).
2. Ensure that your personal information has been completed accurately.
3. Once you have earned 100 points submit this tracking sheet to the guidance office.

1. Keep accurate records of club/organization members.
2. Determine the number of points each student has earned using the guide (next pages) and your professional opinion/discretion.
