WHY ATTEND PARENTS' NIGHT WHEN MY CHILD IS IN SECONDARY SCHOOL?

- You can gain valuable insights into your child's development by talking with his/her teachers.
- You could share information about your child that could assist teachers in being most helpful to your child.
- If your child is achieving well and appears to have no major problems, it is still important to demonstrate that your interest in his/her education is just as strong as it was when your child was in elementary school.
- If the report card indicates that your child is experiencing difficulty in one or more subjects, it would be very helpful for you to meet with teacher(s) and the counsellor to discuss problem areas and develop strategies for improvement.
- Your involvement in your child's education is a positive indicator of your ongoing interest in, and support of your child. A post-interview discussion with your child could help strengthen your relationship with your child.

A GUIDELINE FOR DISCUSSION AT THE INTERVIEW

- You might find it helpful to hear the teacher's perceptions of your child's strengths and areas for development. You might provide the teacher with information regarding your observations of your child's strengths, interests, aspirations.
- You could ask for specific suggestions to assist you in supporting your child's learning and achievement in a particular subject area.
- You might find it helpful for the teacher to review homework expectations so you can reinforce them with your child.
- You might ask your child's counsellor about educational/career planning.
