# STIDENT PARKING: All students who intend to park a



car at school will be required to display in their vehicle a Student Parking Permit for the 2016-2017 school year. The application is available from the attendance office as of Sept. 7, 2016. Permits will be issued once the agreement is signed. One permit is required per

vehicle. Students must park their vehicles in the east parking lot near the basketball courts during the school day.



It is the student's responsibility to check his/her timetable for accuracy.

- You must carry 8 courses (4 per semester) unless you are in your graduating year and have earned a minimum of 23 credits.
- Please make sure you have successfully completed the correct pre-requisites for all your scheduled courses.
- Check the sequences of your courses. The pre-requisite course must be in the first semester followed by the next course in semester 2.
- If you attended summer school you may need your timetable adjusted.
- Make sure you have the courses you need for graduation and/or post-secondary plans.

Counsellors will only make changes due to summer school, missing courses, incorrect sequencing or graduation requirements.


