Parents, Guardians, and Students:

As you are aware, our school Prom is soon approaching. Traditionally, this event brings great excitement and wonderful memories for the vast majority of students who choose to attend.

Tickets this year will include dinner and dancing at Mississauga Convention Centre, located at 75 Derry Road W, Mississauga, from 5:30 pm – 11:00 pm on Friday, June 7, 2019.

Students should listen to the morning announcements to confirm the ticket sale dates for School Cash Online. All ticket purchases are non-refundable and non-transferable. **No independent ticket sales or exchanges are allowed.** Only School Cash Online will be accepted at <https://peelschools.schoolcashonline.com/>. From **January 7<sup>th</sup> to January 14<sup>th</sup>**, Early Bird tickets will be sold for \$85 per person. From February 4<sup>th</sup> to February 22<sup>nd</sup> there will be another round of ticket sales at \$90 per ticket. If there are spaces still available, ticket sales will continue to be sold the week before March Break---students should listen to the announcements for more information (space permitting).

In addition to ticket sales, students must have paid the **\$20 gr 12 Student Activity Fees** as this subsidized many costs not included in ticket pricing.

A table will be set up outside the cafeteria by the Prom Committee during the first half of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> period lunches Jan 9-11, 2019 & the week beginning February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 to collect **Permission Forms and Guest Application Forms.**

Students must understand that their behaviour before and during the Formal must meet the expectations of the school's Code of Conduct. Upon entering the venue there are no in and out privileges. Students participating in inappropriate behaviour, including students who are found to be in possession or under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs, will be subject to school-based discipline which will include suspension as well as withdrawal from the event. Should this occur, parents/guardians will be required to pick the student up from the Prom venue. Every student and invited guests, must provide contact information for his or her parent or guardian. David Suzuki Secondary School's expectations for appropriate student behaviour also apply to any guest attending the event with a David Suzuki Secondary School student.

Please note that, upon arrival, students will be subjected to a search to ensure a safe event for everyone. Teachers, administration, and police officers will be present. Also, students will be required to present photo identification, such as their Student Activity Card, along with the ticket to enter the event.

We ask that you stress with your son or daughter the importance of enjoying the formal in a responsible manner. In support of this, all DSSS students attending the formal must attend the Mothers' Against Drunk Driving presentation on December 18<sup>th</sup>. Should a student miss the assembly, the student will be required to watch the video recording of the same presentation with Mrs. Prasad. Finally, students must complete all their community volunteer hours to attend.
