1. For **College** information, visit [www.ontariocolleges.ca](http://www.ontariocolleges.ca) >Discover >Find a Program (i.e. Practical Nursing) For **University** information, visit [www.electronicinfo.ca](http://www.electronicinfo.ca) >Find a Program >(i.e. Registered Nurse)
2. OR **Google** ...Click Canadian sites - Then type in Specific College or University
3. OR go to the Post-Secondary Planner on [www.myBluePrint.ca](http://www.myBluePrint.ca)
