Bussing

Locks, Lockers & Valuables

- Lockers are loaned to students for use through the school year. Lockers will be assigned in home room starting Wednesday, September 6th.
- To be assigned a locker, students are to **provide their own lock**, and combinations must be given to their teacher. Locker combinations are recorded and stored in the office.
- Students should keep their combinations secret and are advised not to bring large amounts of money or valuable items to school. The sharing of lockers is discouraged and any locks not on an assigned locker will be removed.
- During Phys. Ed class, wallets, personal technology and other valuables should be left in student's personal locker.
- A limited number of locks are available for sale in the main office for \$5.00.

If you need to reach your child

We encourage you to make arrangements with your child before they leave for school in the morning. If you must reach your child for an emergency please call the school and press "0" for reception. We cannot page students during class hours and will not interrupting classes. During certain times of the day such as lunch or gym it may be difficult to track them down.

Student Absences and Students Leaving Early
