Dear LPSS students and guardians

On **Wednesday, June 6** and **Thursday, June 7**, all students in semester two Grade 9 Math classes at LPSS will be writing the **EQAO Provincial Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics**. At the same time, all Grade 9 students NOT writing the EQAO Provincial Math test will write a **Literacy Practice Test** in preparation for their EQAO Provincial Grade 10 Assessment of Literacy next year.

LPSS will be following a *late-start day* timetable for both June 6 and June 7. The EQAO Math Test and the Literacy Practice Test will be administered from 8:20 am to 9:40 am on both mornings. All other classes will begin at 9:45 am. Please see the schedule below.

Students who are bussed to LPSS can come on their bus at the regular time. Supervised study will be provided in the library.

Grade 10, 11, 12 students not writing either test should plan to be at the school for 9:30 am in order to be ready for the start of class at 9:45 am.

The month of June is a very busy month as students complete final performance assessments and prepare for formal final exams. Please note that these shortened days do not interfere with in-class evaluations. Staff and students are aware that classes are 55 minutes on these two days and any in-class assessment reflects this change.
