For the portraiture lighting assignments you are required to write a creative short story.</li> <li>• To retouch and make corrections to the photographs you do a series of Adobe Lightroom tutorials.</li> <li>• You may use your phone for some projects and you may use point and shoot cameras (also provided) when needed.</li> </ul> <p>There is usually one field trip for this course. It is to an outdoor location where you work in teams to find image outlines in a team Challenge Scavenger Hunt. Final 30% consist of a Webfolio (15%) done on “Weebly” and Studio Portraiture (15%)..</p>	<p>Use just your phone to take photographs.</p>
