



# Meadowvale Post Secondary Fair

Dear Parents & Guardians of Grade 11 and 12 Students:

On Tuesday October 17, Meadowvale Secondary School will be hosting a large-scale Post Secondary Fair for approx. 1000 senior students. Students from Streetsville Secondary, West Credit Secondary and Mississauga Secondary School will be joining Meadowvale for the event. Over 50 Ontario colleges and universities will be in attendance. The agenda for grade 11 and 12 students on this day will be as follows:

8:30 am-9:30 am: Students will attend their period one classes as regularly scheduled. During this time students will be given the schedules of the organized workshops.

9:30 am-10:30 am: Students will visit booths set up by the post secondary schools to discuss program/degree choices with each school's representatives. At this time students may consider which four consecutive post secondary sessions they would like to attend:

Session 1	10:40 am - 11:00 am
Session 2	11:05 am - 11:25 am
Session 3	11:30 am - 11:50 pm
Session 4	11:55 pm - 12:05 pm

**\*\*NOTE: If you arrive at a session and it is at capacity, choose another workshop to attend for that scheduled session.**

12:05 pm-12:45 pm: Lunch: Students will be able to purchase pizza/pop in the front foyer.

12:45 pm-2:45 pm: Teaching staff will be available for remedial help. Students should book individual appointments the week before the fair.

Please be aware that applications for post secondary programs are much more competitive at post secondary institutions located in the Greater Toronto Area. Consequently, we highly recommend that students look at all of their options and attend at least two sessions from a smaller post secondary institution that may be located outside of the Greater Toronto Area.

The college and university application process will begin in mid-late November. It is expected that all grade 12 students will take advantage of the valuable information and resources that will be available to them on this day. Grade 11 students are being provided the opportunity to learn about course prerequisites so they can begin planning for their grade 12 year.

We look forward to providing students with an educational, action packed day that focuses on their future goals and post secondary choices.
