Code of Behaviour for Student/Athletes at Port Credit Secondary School

All student/athletes are expected to:

1. Uphold the highest ideals of sportsmanship and fair play towards team-mates, opponents, coaches, game officials, and spectators.
2. Fulfill all academic responsibilities including:
 - will attend all classes on a game day
 - will not skip classes
 - will have no more than 5 lates per month
 - will get work and make arrangements to write tests in advance of any absence
3. Dress according to standards established by coaches and team members.
4. Travel via school transportation unless otherwise specified by the coaching staff.
5. Have paid the required activity fee (\$30.00) and any other fees specific to the team they are participating on (uniform, entry fees, tournaments, etc).
6. Accept responsibility for all equipment issued to them.
7. Not bring food and drinks into the gyms and school facilities.
8. Not enter equipment rooms without the permission of a teacher or coach.
9. Will not enter the gym or other school facility without a supervising staff member.

BEING A MEMBER OF A SCHOOL TEAM IS A PRIVILEGE AND THIS PRIVILEGE MAY BE WITHDRAWN AT ANY TIME DURING THE SEASON FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

1. Displaying conduct during practice, in travel, or at competitions which reflect poorly on the team or school such as, but not restricted to:
 - Obscene language
 - Gestures perceived as disrespectful, aggressive, or violent
 - Arguing with officials
2. Failing to abide by team rules as set out by the coaches. This includes, but is not limited to the use of drugs or alcohol, smoking, stealing, and missing practice.
3. Failing to maintain acceptable standards in classes by demonstrating poor attendance, tardiness, incomplete work, etc.
