#### TO DO BEFORE August 30th:

**NEW School Cash Online System** for all schools in Peel. It provides convenience to parents and increases school efficiency with payment intake. School Cash Online offers parents an easy to use account with 24/7 access. No bank information input is required. Pay all fees with credit or debit card.

#### 2017-2018 Student Activity Fee: \$30.00

Your student activity card allows you to participate in the following extra-curricular activities for the 2017-2018 school year: Student Council supported activities, intramurals, teams, clubs, assemblies, and the Arts. It also includes a \$5.00 printing credit. Your student activity fee supports all student activities, helps supports student life at the school, and keeps all extra-curricular events and activities affordable for our school community. Often these experiences become the most memorable part of a student's school life. The School Yearbook is also available to students.

The yearbook is normally \$45 but when paid through the cashless system at Check-In, the cost is reduced to \$40.

Parents are responsible for setting up their NEW School Cash Online account.

All school fees in Peel will be paid online. No bank information is required. Pay with debit or credit card.

Parents can print receipts.

Photographs	required for your photograph. Student cards must be carried at all times and will be required		
	for any formal assessments, admission to some sporting events, Prom and Commencement.		
	Replacement cards are \$5.00 each. Parents are encouraged to take a picture of the student card as		
	a record of the student number. Your card will be printed on August 30th and given to you. You will		
	need it to pick up your timetable at the next station.		
Station 4:	It is essential that you keep your timetable with you at all times throughout the school year. This		
Timetables &	includes crucial policies and expectations (yellow card) which will outline your responsibilities and		
Handouts	strategies to achieve success.		

It is very important to **keep** the signed copy of the Check-in Form in a safe place as **it is your receipt** for fees paid.

Also, you may need to show this receipt when you pick up your yearbook in June.
