

Dramatic Arts (Grade 9 – Open, ESL)

ADA 10L

This course is only available to students taking ESL AO and ESL BO.

This course provides opportunities to explore dramatic forms and techniques, using material from a wide range of sources and cultures. Students, who are new to Canada will use the elements of Drama to examine situations and issues that are relevant to their lives. Students will create, perform, discuss and analyze Drama, and then reflect on the experiences to develop an understanding of themselves, the art form, and the world around them.

By the end of the course the students will demonstrate skills in each of the three Dramatic Arts strands:

- **Creating and Presenting:** identify and use a variety of strategies to improve reading, writing, and oral communication in English
- **Reflecting, Responding, and Analyzing:** demonstrate an understanding of the critical analysis process, and make connections beyond the classroom
- **Foundations:** Identify and use a variety of dramatic concepts and terminology to improve their learning skills and English communication skills, for the classroom and beyond
