

English, Grade 11 – University Preparation
ENG 3U0

This course emphasizes the consolidation of the literary, communication, and critical and creative thinking skills necessary for success in academic and daily life. Students will analyse a range of challenging literary texts from various periods, countries, and cultures; interpret and evaluate informational and graphic texts; and create oral, written, and media texts in a variety of forms. Texts regularly studied in this course include, but are not limited to: *Lord of the Flies*, *Macbeth*, *The Colour Purple*, *The Namesake*, *The Power of One*, *Catcher in the Rye* and *Little Bee*. An important focus will be on using academic language coherently and confidently, selecting the reading strategies best suited to particular texts and particular purposes for reading, and developing greater control in writing. The course is intended to prepare students for university, college, or the workplace.

Prerequisite: English, Grade 10, Academic (ENG 2D)
