Career Studies, Grade 10 – Open GLC 200

This course teaches students how to develop and achieve personal goals in education and work. Students will assess their own skills and characteristics, explore post-secondary education, investigate economic trends, workplace organizations, and ways to search for work.

Overall Expectations:

- Identify interest, skills, characteristics and accomplishments
- Describe the personal management skills and characteristics to succeed in each aspect of life
- Demonstrate effective interpersonal skills
- Demonstrate the ability to research information about learning and work
- Demonstrate knowledge of the world of work and trends in society and the economy
- Produce personal documentations (e.g. resume, portfolios) to assist in the work search
- Use appropriate decision-making methods to set goals and develop an action plan
