Who Can Apply for College?

Students graduating from the Applied Skilled Trades Program, Year 5 Post-Secondary Pathway Program and Vocational Level 2 Program.

Steps for Applying

1. Speak to your Guidance Counsellor.
2. Research programs of interest.
3. Determine prerequisites (and/or admission requirements) for programs of interest.
4. Create a student profile on <http://www.ontariocolleges.ca>
5. Select a maximum of 5 programs at 3 colleges.
6. Pay the \$95 application fee.
