CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENT ATHLETES

The Woodlands School is proud of its history of competition, sportsmanship, respect and fair play in high school athletics. In order to preserve this reputation all student athletes are required to adhere to the rules and guidelines listed below in addition to the Code of Behaviour set out by the governing body (ROPSSAA/OFSAA) of high school sports in Ontario. It must also be understood that representing The Woodlands in athletics is a privilege and that learning is the fundamental principle governing all aspects of this program.

It is therefore expected that parent(s)/guardian(s) and student athletes read the information below carefully and agree to abide by these guidelines before giving permission to participate in the athletics program at The Woodlands.

1. All student athletes **must** fulfill their academic requirements and responsibilities to be eligible for participation. This includes completing **all** course work and attending **all** classes **regularly**. Excessive absences or incomplete course work may result in the removal of athletic privileges.
2. Student athletes must attend all scheduled practices and competitions on time. The coach should be notified of the student athlete's intention to be absent prior to any competition or practice.
3. Any student, after being selected as a team member, who quits or is removed from that team, will be ineligible for interschool teams for a period of up to one year. Reinstatement due to extenuating circumstances may be allowed by the school only after a meeting with the student, the coach, the Principal, the athletic contact and the parent/guardian of the athlete.
4. When representing The Woodlands, athletes are expected to behave in a responsible and respectful manner remembering the excellent reputation former athletes have established for the school. **All** school rules apply to athletes participating for The Woodlands.
5. All athletes are required to travel to and from competitions via the transportation arranged by the school unless otherwise specified by the coach or school administration.
